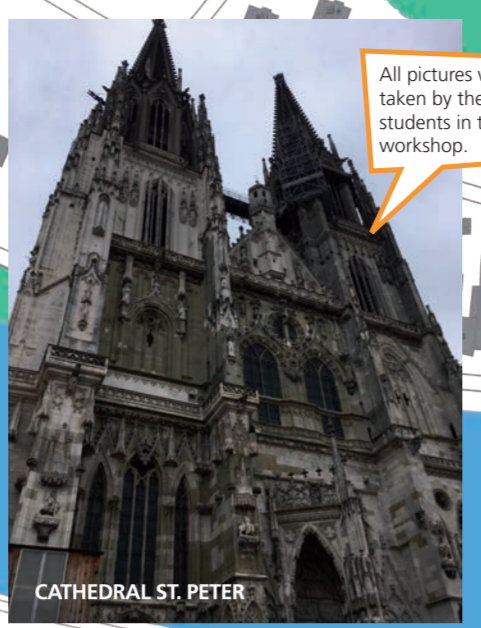
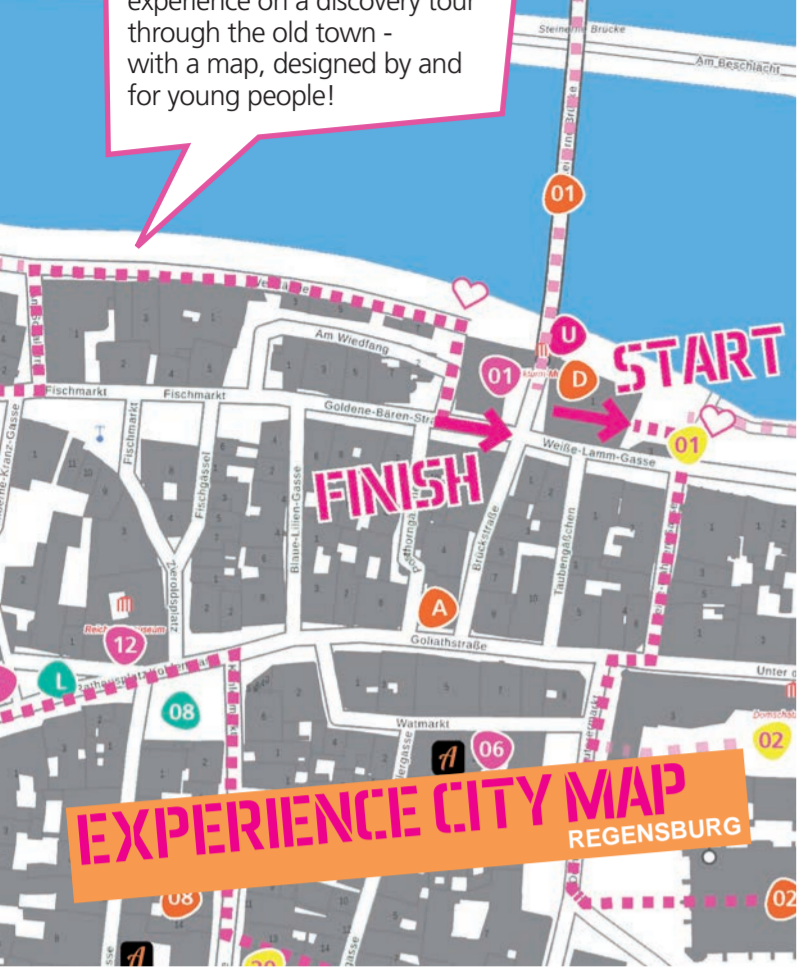

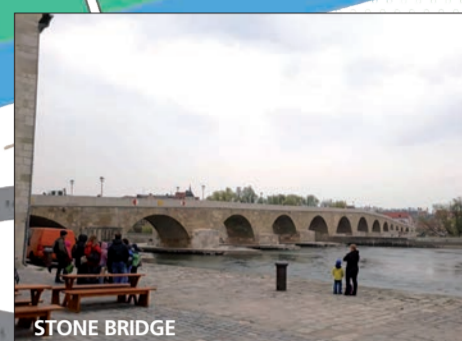

- 01 WORLD HERITAGE VISITOR CENTRE**  
Information about the unique history of the town
- 02 DANUBE LANDING PLACE**  
Great view, historic ship, harbour tours with the Danube Maritime Museum
- 03 MUSEUM OF BAVARIAN HISTORY**  
A museum of the future for the history of the past
- 04 ROMAN WALL**
- 05 PORTA PRAETORIA**  
A preserved Roman gate
- 06 HOUSE OF OSCAR SCHINDLER**
- 07 DOMSCHATZMUSEUM**  
Treasury in the historic rooms of the episcopal residence
- 01 STONE BRIDGE**  
Built in the Middle Ages, renovated 2018
- 02 DOM ST. PETER**  
One of the most important Gothic cathedrals in Germany, sculpture „Judensau“
- 03 STIFTSKIRCHE UNSERER LIEBEN FRAU ZUR ALTEN KAPELLE**  
Peaceful place in the city center
- 04 SCHREINERHAUS**  
Unusual modern building from 1965 in fairfaced concrete
- 05 MINORITENKIRCHE**  
Empty former church, used for concerts and exhibitions
- 01 WURSTKUCHEL**  
Historic sausage kitchen, delicious sausage takeaway, view to the stonebridge
- 02 BIERGARTEN BISCHOFSHOF**  
In the historic courtyard
- 03 CAFE ORLANDO DI LASSO**  
Old style café
- 04 MARKTHALLE**  
Very central, different kinds of fastfood in a mall
- 05 CAFE FÜRSTENHOF**  
Very fancy café in a remarkable building
- 06 TARACAFÉ**  
Vegetarian and vegan café
- 07 WEISSES BRÄUHAUS**  
Historic Bavarian tavern
- 08 BUCHHANDLUNG DOMBROWSKY**  
Bookshop with some special recommendations
- 09 CAFÉ ANTOINETTE**  
Fine kitchen, in a glasshouse
- 10 BRAUHAUS AM SCHLOSS**  
Traditional inn
- 11 „SCHAU HI“ (LOOK SHRAP)**  
Neupfarrpl. 16 u. Obere Bachgasse 19 two stylish papershops, connected by a „guidance for consciously flowing“: Visit one of the shops, take a sheet with you and float through Regensburg ...
- 08 HISTORIC MUSEUM**  
Art and cultural history from the Stone Age to the 19th century of the town
- 09 ROMAN WALL**  
Remainings of the legion camp under a car park
- 10 STADTTHEATER**  
The municipal theatre  
Tickets for students from € 5,50
- 11 NEUPFARRKIRCHE**  
Multireligious place: Protestant church, built on the former jewish ghetto
- 12 IMPERIAL DIET**  
From 1663 to 1806, the Everlasting Reichstag brought great german and european politics to Regensburg
- 13 JOHANNES-KEPLER-HAUS**  
Gives a good insight into Kepler's life and work
- 06 NEW SYNAGOGUE**  
At the location of the destroyed synagogue, not open for public, paper construction kit: [www.bauwärts.de/synagoge](http://www.bauwärts.de/synagoge)
- 07 BASILICA ST. EMMERAM**  
An impressive church building begun in around 780 with a remarkable crypt
- 08 GOLDENER TURM**  
The towers from the 13th century served rich patrician families as a status symbol
- 09 THON-DITTMER-PALAIS**  
Public library, Open-air theater
- 12 LITERATURCAFE**  
Nice small bookshop with café
- 13 MARPLE AND STRINGER**  
Pub, oldschool style
- 14 STENZ**  
Fine ice cream
- 15 CAFÉ WEICHMANN**  
Nice café with a silent, green courtyard
- 16 PUSTET BOOKSHOP**  
Store and café, cosy place to read a book or to meet
- 17 GESANDTENSTRASSE**  
Lot of shops nearby
- 18 NEUPFARRPLATZ**  
Lot of shops
- 19 WHAT THE KIOSK?**  
A very different kind of kiosk, with magazines, art and coffee mandations
- 20 DAS DEGGINGER**  
Creative place with exhibitions, concerts
- 21 LILA STREETFOOD**  
Cosy place, enjoy baked potatoes or bulgur
- 22 BRAUEREI KNEITINGER**  
Cute old inn of the brewery with magazines, art and coffee
- 23 SPITALGARTEN**  
Very german beergarden
- 24 EISGALERIE**  
Icecream at the other side of the bridge
- 06 GUTENBERGPLATZ**  
Quiet pocket park in the city center
- 07 NEUPFARRPLATZ**  
Central square with shops, many cafés in a friendly atmosphere
- 08 KOHLENMARKT**  
Benches in the shade, cafés, shops
- 09 HOLZLÄNDE**  
View on Danube and the city fresh air, silence
- 10 PLAYGROUND SCHEUGÄSSCHEN**  
A silent place to chill

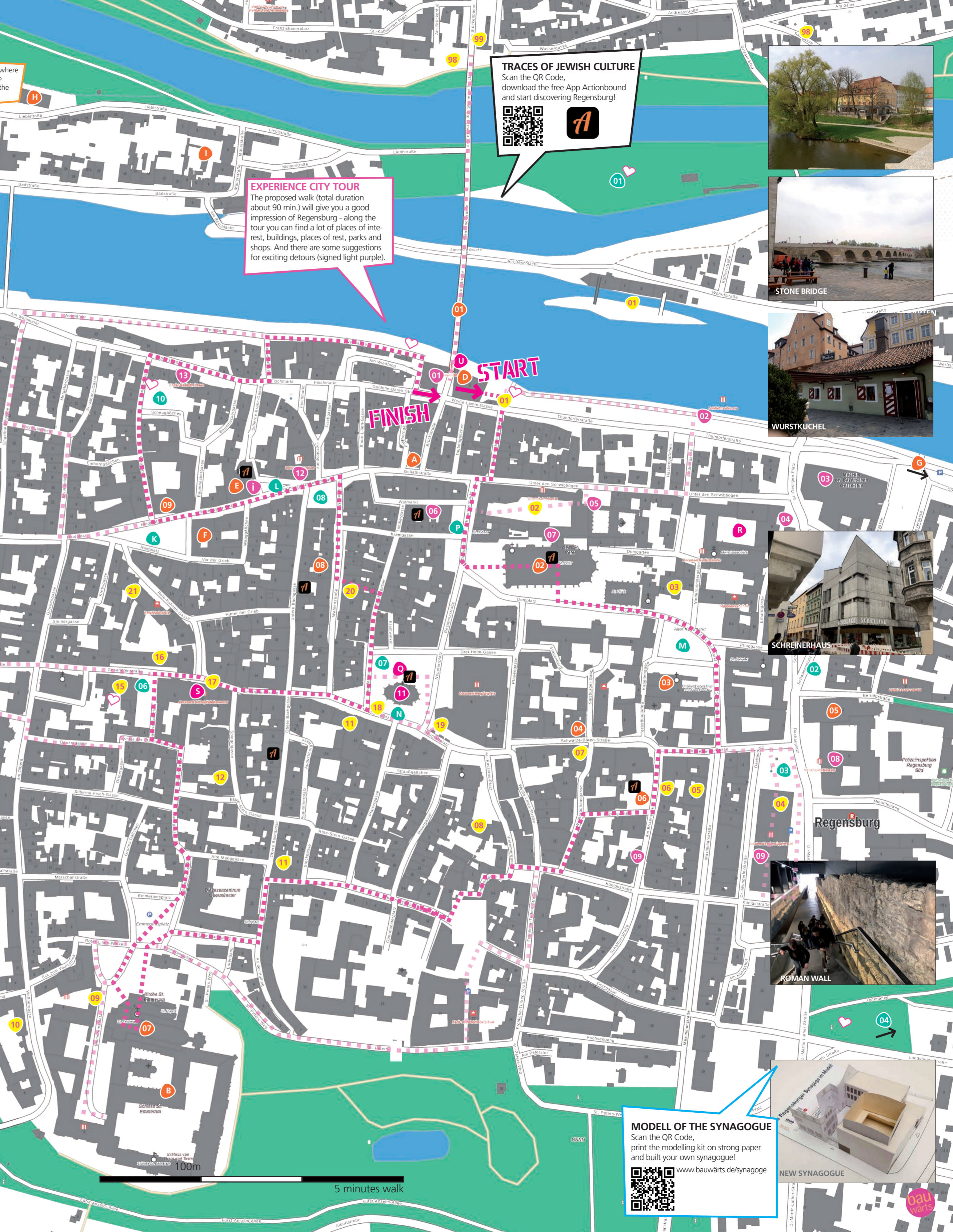

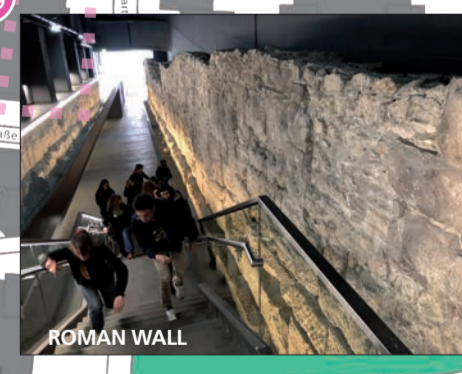

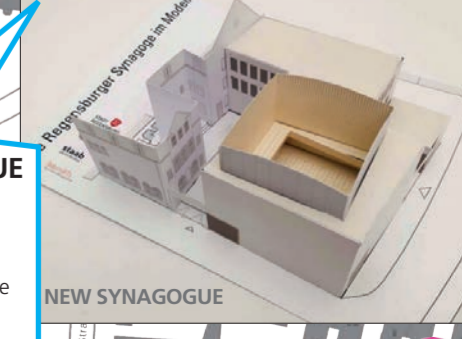

## EXPERIENCE CITY MAP REGENSBURG

This map was developed in April 2019 during an European educational project in Regensburg with students from Sweden, Portugal, Spain and Germany (Donau Gymnasium Kelheim). The projects aim is the implementation of the method "learning through service" in the field of culture and world heritage. It is funded by World Heritage Coordination Regensburg.

## ARCHITECTURAL MONUMENTS

- 01 STONE BRIDGE**  
  
 A Wonder of the World.
- 01 WURSTKUCHL**  
  
 The famous "Historic Sausage Kitchen" is the oldest sausage kitchen in the world
- 08 GOLDEN TOWER**  
  
 The highest „house“ tower in the World Heritage City Regensburg.
- A GOLIATH HOUSE**  
  
 The Goliath House with its painting of the fight between David and Goliath, is one of Regensburg's landmarks.
- B THURN AND TAXIS PALACE**  
  
 This magnificent palace emerged from the buildings of the former Benedictine monastery of St. Emmeram
- C JAKOBSTOR**  
  
 The Jakobstor was one of the four Gothic entrance gates of the 14th century city fortifications.
- D SALZSTADEL**  
  
 The Salt Warehouse, built from 1616 to 1620, stands in the immediate vicinity of the Stone Bridge and houses the World Heritage Visitor Centre.
- E OLD TOWN HALL**  
  
 From 1663 to 1806 the Perpetual Imperial Assembly met in the Imperial Chamber.
- F NEUE WAAG**  
  
 This building from the 14th century at the Haiplatz housed the municipal scales from 1441 on.
- G ROYAL VILLA**  
  
 This park owes its name to the royal villa of King Maximilian II of Bavaria.
- H ANDREASSTADEL**  
  
 The two-storey Salzstadel served the free Bavarian salt trade, which was obstructed by the city Regensburg by customs collection.
- I THE SPITAL AREA**  
  
 The area is a medieval complex of European renown. Each building has its own history and all together make up the charm of the district.

## GOD HOUSES

- 02 ST. PETER'S CATHEDRAL**  
  
 The city's spiritual centre. St. Peter's Cathedral is the only Gothic Cathedral in Bavaria.
- 02 ALL SAINTS CHAPEL**  
  
 The important Romance central building of the Allerheiligenkapelle stands in the eastern cloister courtyard.
- 03 THE OLD CHAPEL**  
  
 In the 18th century the Romanesque basilica was magnificently rebuilt in the Bavarian rococo style.
- 07 ST. EMMERAM'S BASILICA**  
  
 St. Emmeram was built during the Carolingian period in the 8th century.
- 11 NEW PARIH CHURCH**  
  
 The Protestant-Lutheran church is the oldest reformation church in Regensburg.
- J ST. JAMES SCOTTICH CHURCH**  
  
 The "Scottish doorway", which faces north, is particularly impressive.
- 06 SYNAGOGUE**  
  
 With great civic engagement, a new synagogue was built on the original site and opened in 2019.

## SQUARES

- 05 BISMARCK SQUARE**  
  
 In the Roman times this square was used as a location for storage-houses and warehouses.
- 07 NEW PARISH SQUARE**  
  
 During the course of rebuilding measures there were extensive archaeological excavations in the former Jewish quarter from 1995 to 1997.
- 08 COAL MARKET AND ZIEROLD SQUARE**  
  
 This square gets its name from its former purpose as a charcoal market for the city's smiths and citizens.
- K HAIDPLATZ**  
  
 The Haidplatz is one of the oldest and most traditional squares in Regensburg's historic Old City.
- L CITY HALL SQUARE**  
  
 In the centre of the Old City the Rathausplatz stretches between the narrow streets.
- M OLD CORN MARKET**  
  
 The Kornmarkt received its name from its former function as a transshipment centre and trading place for grain.
- N CATHEDRAL SQUARE**  
  
 This square in the heart of the Old City has been a favourite meeting-place for local people and visitors since the Middle Ages.
- O ARNULF'S SQUARE**  
  
 In mediaeval times this area was situated outside the city walls and was used principally as a place for storage and executions.
- P HERB MARKET**  
  
 The small "Krauterer Markt" is formed by the northern extension of the Domplatz.

- FREE TAP WATER**  
  
 At all cafés and bars with this sticker on the window you get free tap water in your own water bottle.
- NICE RESTROOM**  
  
 For the „Nette Toilette“ campaign, Regensburg restaurant owners are making their restrooms available to the public for free.
- BUS AND TRAIN**  
  
 On this page you find further informations for seasonal offers, more details for using the Regensburg Card as well as various offers on events. Ticket: € 2,40 and € 1,30 (u 16).

## DOCUMENT

- 04 document LEGIONSLAGERMAUER**  
  
 The „document Legionslager“ – the Roman wall.
- 05 document PORTA PRETORIA**  
  
 Germany's most ancient stone building, the Porta Praetoria, a gateway dating from 179 A. D.
- 12 document REICHSTAG**  
  
 Experience the history of Europe and of the Empire, as well as urban legal history at the authentic place.
- 13 document KEPLERHAUS**  
  
 The famous astronomer Johannes Kepler died in Regensburg in the 17th century during his visit in the medieval city.
- Q document NEUPFARRPLATZ**  
  
 Regensburg's greatest excavations. The cross-section takes you from the Roman officers' dwellings through the medieval Jewish quarter to a shelter from World War II.
- R document NIEDERMÜNSTER**  
  
 Discover the Roman foundations of Regensburg and the layers of Middle Ages in a spectacular tour.
- S document SCHNUPFTABAKFABRIK**  
  
 The building of the document Schnupftabakfabrik (engl. Snuff Factory) is over 800 years old and is a special highlight in the heart of the Old Town.

## MUSEUMS

- 03 MUSEUM OF BAVARIAN HISTORY**  
  
 The History of Bavaria - from the Kingdom of Bavaria to the Present Day.
- 08 HISTORIC MUSEUM/ MINORITENKIRCHE**  
  
 The museum in the former Minorite Monastery shows the history, art and culture of Regensburg from the Stone Age to the present day.
- T EAST GERMAN GALLERY**  
  
 The Kunstforum is an excellent museum of modern art.
- L BRIDGE TOWER MUSEUM**  
  
 It is located in a surviving tower of the Stone Bridge. From the top, there is a magnificent view of the Danube and the roofs of the town.
- 02 DANUBE SHIPPING MUSEUM**  
  
 The museum is on board two historic Danube ships with a variety of original rooms accessible. Models and display boards provide an insight into the history of shipping.
