

The education passport is available free of charge for all (new) immigrants and migrants to use voluntarily and is recommended from the age of 15/16.

The passport consists of an A4 folder and includes the following points:

- ✓ Summary of the regional contact points
- ✓ Personal details about the education passport holder
- ✓ Ready-made CV to be filled in by hand or online for simple guidance
- ✓ Template to evidence work experience, voluntary further education courses etc.

You can also collect and file all the documents relevant to your education and career in your folder.

Please always bring your education passport with you when

- ... you go to a consultation appointment
- ... you introduce yourself to an employer or work experience company
- ... you introduce yourself to an education provider

You can get your copy from the information centres you are already aware of and at the vocational integration and transition classes. We recommend that you get assistance with filling it in from an information centre that's familiar to you.

Are you an asylum seeker or someone with exceptional leave to remain?

We would like to point out that the use of an education passport does not have any effect on your asylum process and application. The Federal Office for Migration and Refugees has the sole decision regarding this. The education passport also does not have any influence on the right of residence for people who have exceptional leave to remain.
