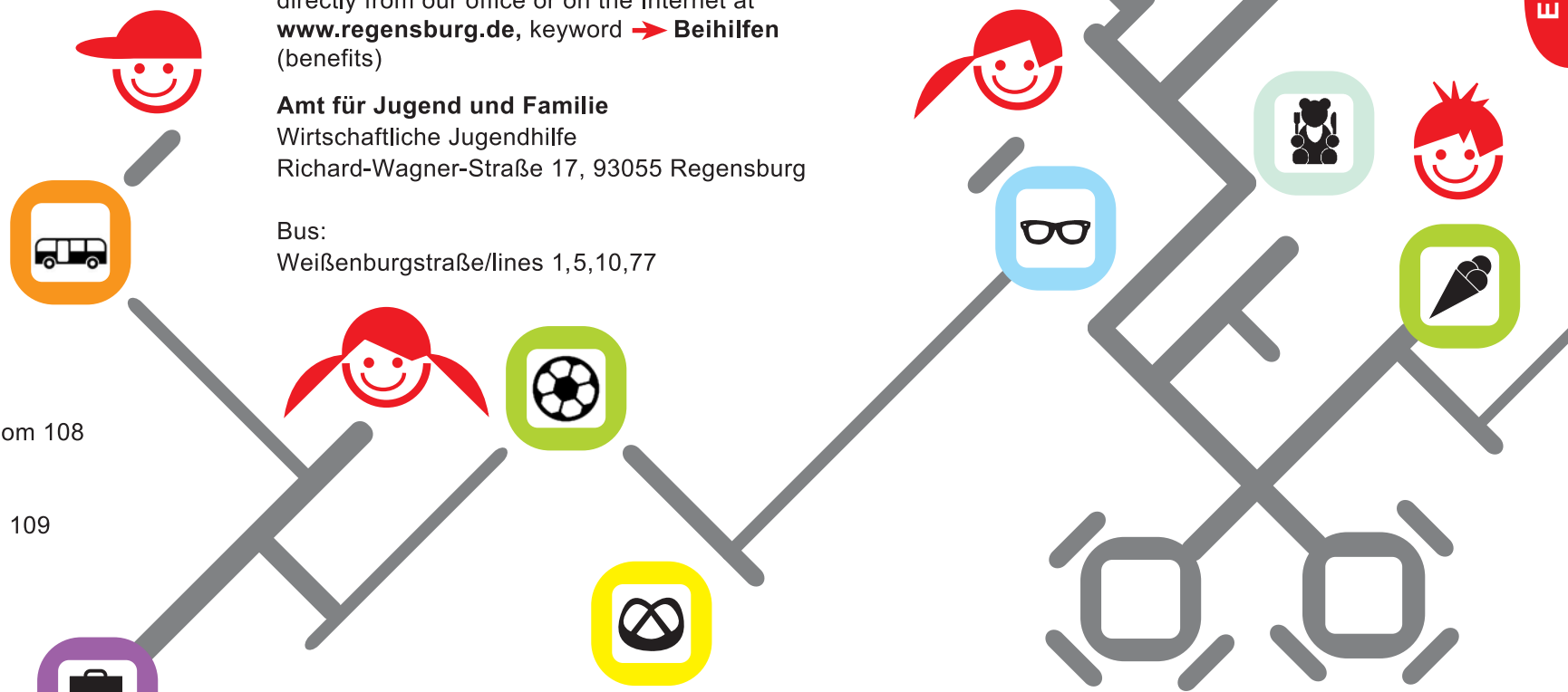

Who is entitled to benefits from the education and participation package?



Those entitled are children and young people from families that receive

- Arbeitslosengeld II (unemployment benefit according to the Social Security Code-SGB)
- Sozialhilfe (basic social security according to SGB XII)
- Wohngeld (housing benefit)
- Kinderzuschlag (supplementary child allowance)
- benefits according to the Asylum Seekers' Benefit Act.

Applications for benefits can be made up to an including the age of 25 with the exception of benefits for the participation in social and cultural life (applications in this regard are only accepted for children under 18)

Personal school supplies:

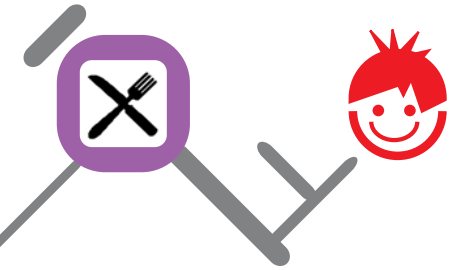
100 Euro total per year
(payment of 70 Euro made in first school semester, 30 Euro in second school semester)

Appropriate special tuition:

for pupils who do not achieve essential learning goals and who are in danger of failing the year. The school must confirm the needs for this.

Pupil transportation:

Travel expenses to the nearest school providing the selected programme are subsidised if the costs are actually necessary and are not otherwise paid by a third party.



Shared lunch in child-minding facilities, day care and school:

We support the regular participation in shared midday meals. Each person 1 Euro per meal and the rest is subsidised.

Contributions towards participation in social and cultural life:

The benefit amounts to a maximum of 10 Euro a month, thus up to 120 Euro a year, and is granted particularly for

- membership in the areas of sports, play and culture
- costs of courses in artistic subjects
- guided activities in cultural education
- participation in organised trips
