

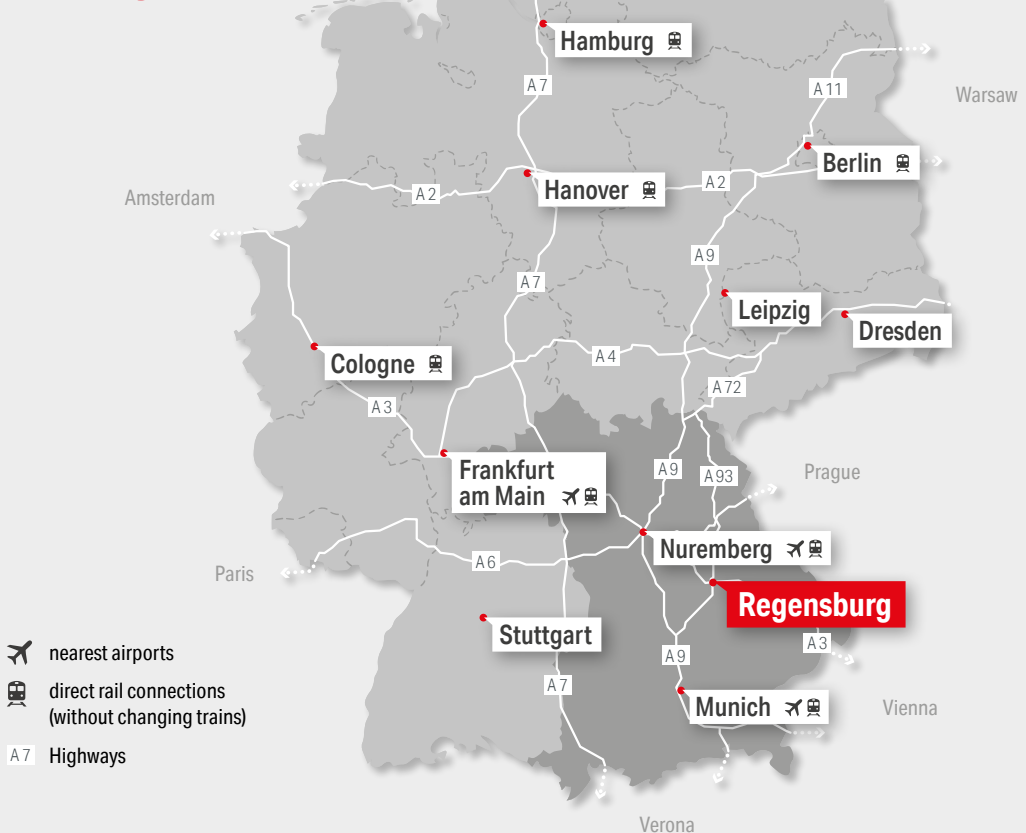

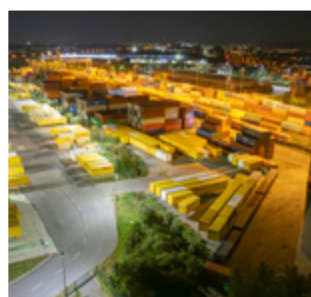


Facts about Regensburg

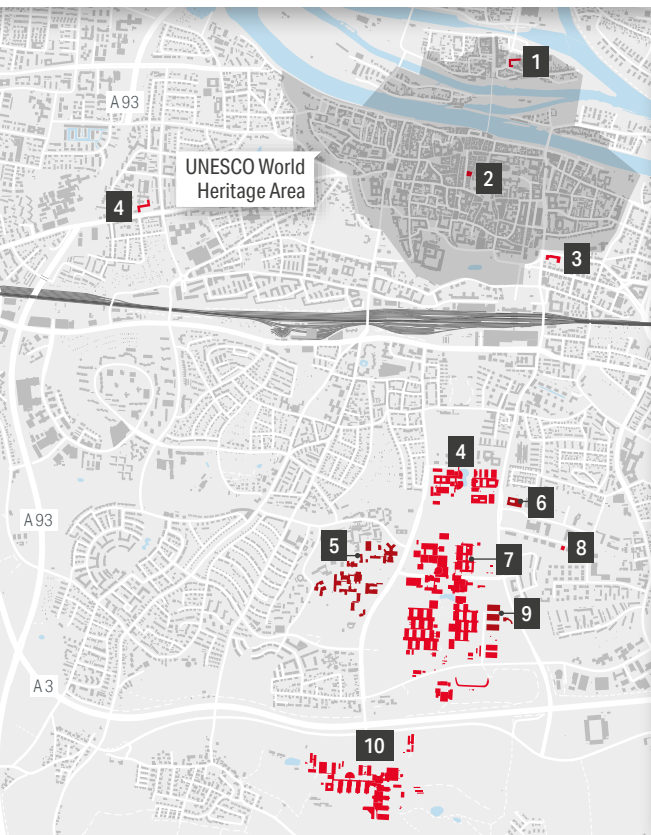
- Located at the **northernmost point of the Danube**, between the natural areas of the Upper Palatinate Jura, the Bavarian Forest, and the Gäuboden plain
- **60 minutes'** drive to the international airports Munich (MUC) und Nuremberg (NUE)
- two **UNESCO World Heritage titles**
- approximately **179,000 inhabitants**
- one of Germany's **highest workplace densities** (165,000+ jobs)
- **catchment area**: 700,000+ people
- **gross domestic product**: approx. 92,000 euros per capita (2024)
- **prime business location** with leading international high-tech enterprises and medium-sized companies, including several hidden champions
- Europe-wide recognized hub for successful **innovation and cluster policy**
- dynamic and innovative **research hub** with two technology and start-up centers (BioPark and TechBase) as well as numerous research and development facilities

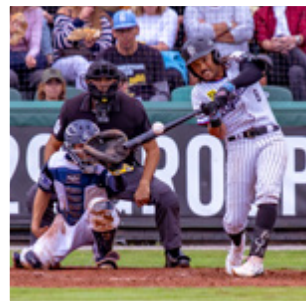

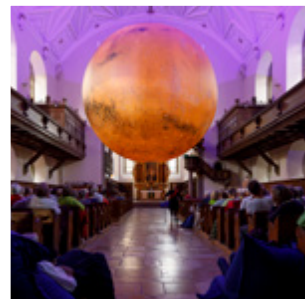
