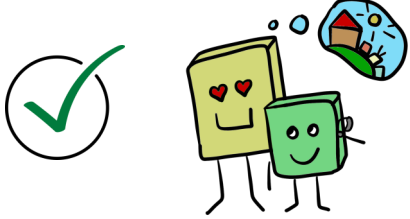
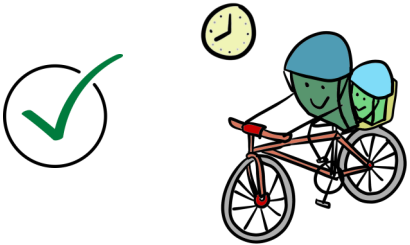


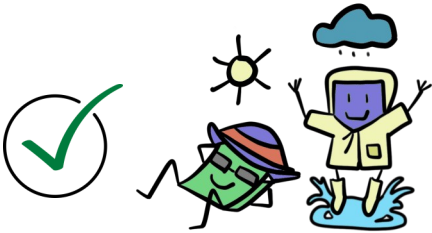
How to help your child at kindergarten:



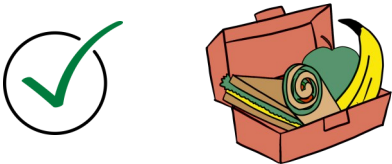
Show your child: **I am happy** that you are at kindergarten!

Provide your child with appropriate **clothing** for all weather conditions.

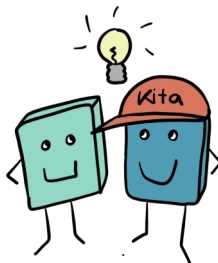


Give your child **breakfast** to take with them: for example, vegetables, fruit and bread. Avoid sugar.

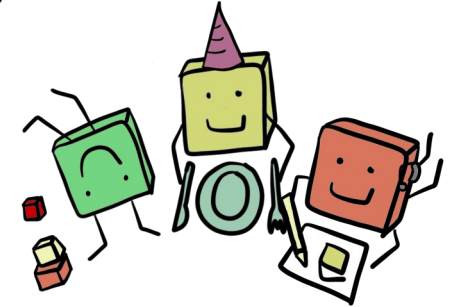
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Welcome to kindergarten

We are delighted to have your child with us!

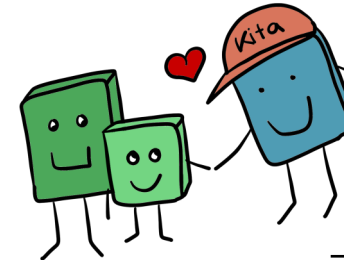
What does your child do at kindergarten?

Your child gets to know other children. We play, do gymnastics, eat, paint and much more. We celebrate birthdays and other festivities. Your child learns a lot and prepares for school.



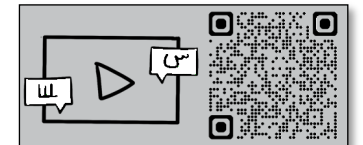
Your child is welcome:

for example, games, stories and songs. You are **invited** to the kindergarten: read a book with the children, sing a song with the children. Your languages are welcome!



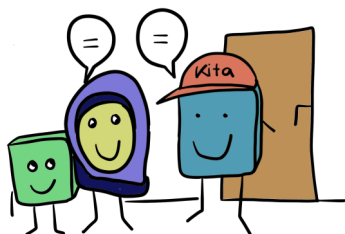
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How do parents and the kindergarten communicate?

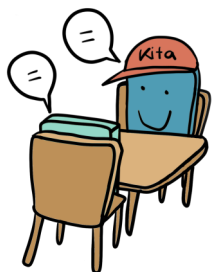
You know your child best: what can you tell us about your child? When parents and kindergarten communicate well, your child can develop well!



Conversations are important...



When dropping off and picking up: you and the childcare staff talk to each other:
How is the child today?



Development meeting: The childcare staff and you make an appointment: What do you want for your child? What is your child already good at? What is your child not yet good at?



Parent event: Many parents and the childcare staff meet. The childcare staff informs you about various topics.

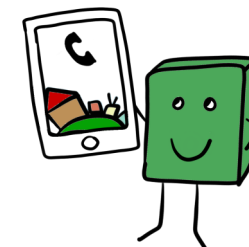
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The childcare staff can organise an **interpreter for you free of charge**. The interpreters do not pass on any information to others.

Please always be **available by telephone**. This is important: for example, if your child falls ill at kindergarten...



... and written information:

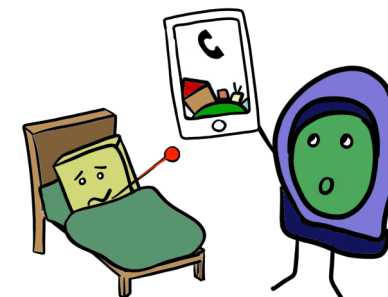


The letter to parents contains important information, for example:

Notices are often posted at the entrance to the kindergarten. For example, the meal plan.
