What we do?

We provide guidance with any issues and problems which can occur in the course of both the development and upbringing of both children and young people, and as part of day to day family life.

For example, we may be contacted about:
Questions regarding a child's difficult behaviour, doubt and uncertainty concerning upbringing, difficulties at either preschool or at school, family disagreements and much more.

The guidance team is made up of experienced staff with various specialisms in the areas of guidance and therapy.

Who can contact us?

Any guidance and counseling are provided on a voluntary basis and are available to

families and single parents, stepfamilies, foster parents and parents by adoption as well as to young people and adults

of all denominations and nationalities

who are resident in the City or District of Regensburg.

What is important to us?

We take the time to answer your questions and to solve problems together.

The advice provided is confidential. All staff are subject to a duty of confidentiality. Without your consent we will not pass on information to other authorities or organisations.

We have interpreters available for various languages who are native speakers. If requested, they are able to support the discussion free of charge and are also subject to a duty of confidentiality.

How can you make an appointment?

You can make an appointment at any time by phone, email or in person at a child guidance center of your choice (contact details are on the back page). Soon afterwards you will receive an invitation to an initial discussion.

The counseling is free of charge and can also be provided anonymously on request.
