

TECHNOLOGY

Beamer

- Vivitek Projector DH91x series
- Remote control beamer
- fixed projection screen 1,60m x 2,80m

Cable

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Beamer

Switch on the beamer at the touch panel on the back of the projection screen.

Please do not forget to switch off.

Laptop > HDMI cable (with adapter if necessary) > HDMI socket (bottom right of the projection screen)

Sound

Switch on by plugging the black power cable into the wall on the right behind the projection screen. Please do not forget to switch off.

BASICS FROM THE USE AGREEMENT (excerpt etc.)

- Recommendation: The number of persons is limited to 20-30 persons.
- Smoking on Tändlergasse is prohibited in the evening.
- The use of smoke and heat generating devices, e.g. fog machines, is prohibited in the DEGGINGER.
- The user has to take care of sufficient liability insurance protection.
- No third-party property can be stored in DEGGINGER before or after events.
- The premises must be left clean.
- Disposal of waste especially packaging material, cardboard boxes is excluded in DEGGINGER.
- Exhibits can be attached to the maritime pine wall by nailing and gluing.
- Exhibits can only be attached to the historical stone walls by gluing. Attention: Adhesive tapes do not hold well on the wall.
- Exhibits may only be attached to the historical stone walls by nailing in individual cases and
 after consultation. Nails may not be driven in deeper than 0.5 cm in order not to endanger the
 historical building fabric.
- The walls may only be painted with silicate paint.
